[Digital New Zealand](#)

This database aggregates New Zealand-related resources at one place. Digital NZ includes videos, newspapers, maps, photographs, audio recordings, artworks, news reports, and many other kinds of digital content. Users can access journals related to New Zealand and research theses from academic institutions of this country.

[New Zealand Research](#)

This database managed by National Library of New Zealand aims to collect all research resources related to New Zealand at one place. As this is powered by Digital NZ database, duplication of documents could be seen.

[CINAHL](#)

[Dynamed](#)

This advanced clinical support tool guides users through current clinical evidence for different medical conditions including mental health. DynaMed topics are continuously updated as new information indicates a need for change in practice or improved understanding of the body of knowledge. IBM Micromedex's drug and laboratory monographs, which includes drug interactions and calculations, are also offered.

Users can manipulate and explore 3D models, allowing you to better visualise and understand human anatomy. For accessing this database, **Chrome browser** is preferred

[Health and Wellness Resource Centre](#)

Provides integrated access to medical, statistical, health, and related information.

[Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition](#)

Provides access to some full text titles that are not available on CINAHL (although, generally CINAHL offers great coverage of journals in nursing and allied health).

[Mednar](#)

Mednar is a search engine that focuses on medical resources available mainly from publicly accessible platforms and the deep web, which is usually not covered by conventional search engines.

[Trip Medical Database](#)

A database that systematically arranges and provides access to resources related to medicines. It facilitates search into different types of resources such as systematic reviews, evidence-based synopses, guidelines etc.

A database that specialises in Systematic reviews

[Merlot](#)

Merlot is one of the leading educational resources databases that collects learning resources such as evidence-based information regarding nursing procedures and instructional videos related to drug calculation. Its collections could be filtered by discipline, audience, material type, peer-review etc.

Databases related to Business studies

[EconBiz](#)

A search portal for studies in business and economics that offers access to full texts on the Internet. EconBiz is continually developed by the German National Library of Economics, world's largest offline and online infrastructure for economic literature.

[Research Papers in Economics](#)

This is the search interface of one of the largest open bibliographic databases, [RePEc](#), dedicated to Economics. A collaborative network of volunteers from over 100 countries, 95 percentage of RePEc's resources are open access. It provides not only access to scholarly articles in economics but also but also other specialised services for economics scholars.

This link provides access to data ranging from International Financial Statistics to Direction of Trade Statistics and other research works published by this international body.

[Marxists Internet Archive](#)

MIA contains the writings of around 850 authors representing a complete spectrum of Marxian political and philosophical thought, spanning the past 200 years. MIA contains writings in 80 different languages, comprising a total size of over 180,000 documents. This archive also contains complete writings of many Marxian thinkers.

[World Bank Open](#)

Free access to books and journals published by World Bank is provided in this link. It also includes external articles published by scholars commissioned by World Bank.

Open access journal databases

[DOAJ Health Journals](#)

A collection of Journals on Health from the World's leading open access journal indexing service, Directory of Open Access Journals.

Users can search for journals in their subject areas using relevant keywords.

[Dove Press Journals](#)

Dove Medical Press, which specialises in medicine and nursing journals, is an open access imprint of Taylor and Francis Group with editorial offices in Auckland. You can also access Dove Journals through the open access journals aggregator, [DOAJ](#). A search interface is available for simple and advanced search.

[Medknow Journals](#)

An imprint of the Wolters Kluwer group, Medknow publishes more than 470 open access journals mainly related to health field and focuses on Asian countries. In their landing page itself, users can search all the articles published in their journals using either key word or author names. Only half of their journals are indexed on DOAJ.

[Directory of Open Access Books](#)

DOAB facilitates free access to peer reviewed open books from reputed publishers. While majority of books are fully downloadable, only certain chapters are allowed in a few.

[MDPI eBooks](#)

MDPI, one of the leading open access publishers, has a collection of more than 3500 books. Most of their books are collections of articles from journals published by MDPI.

[National Academic Press Open](#)

The National Academies Press (NAP) publishes the reports of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine of USA, and provides free access to more than 10,000 books.

[OASIS](#)

Being a search tool for open access resources, Oasis brings together open access books listed under different directories at one place. As Oasis search all types of OA materials, users have to limit their results to three categories, namely Open access books, text books, and public domain books, listed under 'types' at the top left-

hand side of the results page to get only book results. Subject, title and author wise search is available.

[OER Commons- Open Textbooks](#)

A collection of textbooks from different educational institutes are classified subject wise here.

[Open Textbook Initiative](#)

Provides access to books and journals published by institutions, mainly Australian Universities, which are members of this collective. The [Australian National University](#) has the largest collection of books.

[Open Textbook Library](#)

A collection of freely downloadable textbooks are available from this link.

[Open Edition](#)

Use the filters under the access policy, namely open access freemium and simple open access to get open access books. Freemium titles are not downloadable but are fully accessible for online reading. As majority of books are in languages other than English, it is good to use the language filter too. As some of the books here are listed in [DOAB](#) and [OASIS](#), some of the freemium titles may be available for full download in these platforms

[Springer eBooks](#)

Provides access to open access eBooks published by Springer under their different imprints, such as Springer Open, BioMedCentral, Nature portfolio, Palgrave MacMillan and Apress.

[Taylor and Francis eBooks](#)

Taylor and Francis group, which includes imprints like Routledge, Dove Press, Cogent OA, has an eBook collection of more than 1100 titles. It covers subject areas ranging from Social sciences to STEM disciplines. While initiating a subject wise search, filter your results by ticking the open access box in the 'filter by' options at the left side of the page.
