## Search our Library Catalogue's print, e-Serials, e-Books, etc collection using DISCOVERY.

- 1. Go to the Library website (<u>https://library.nmit.ac.nz</u>) to find the DISCOVERY search box.
- 2. Search option one:
  - From the DISCOVERY search box, click in the radio box beside Catalogue only.
  - Put in your search terms in place of the 'Type your search' text prompt (e.g. Type in keyword search Treaty of Waitangi), then



press the Enter key or click on **Search DISCOVERY**.

- You'll be taken to the DISCOVERY platform with Library Catalogue search results displayed.
- 3. Search option two:
  - From the DISCOVERY search box, click on Search DISCOVERY.
  - Once you are on the DISCOVERY platform, put in your search terms in place of the '*Type your search*' text prompt (e.g. type in keyword search *Treaty of Waitangi*) and press the Enter key or click on the magnifying glass.
  - Once your search results display, you will now see an **All filters** button under the search box.
  - Click on this button to bring up the full filters menu to the right.
