You can set up your Google Scholar to link to full text online resources provided by NMIT.

1. Open Google Scholar (https://scholar.google.com) and click on the pancake menu at top left.



2. From the drop-down menu, select **Settings.**



3. From the **Settings** options, click on the **Library links** tab.

5. A list of libraries will appear. Tick in the box beside **NMIT | Te Pūkenga (Nelson Marlborough Institute of Technology - NMIT Fulltext** and click on the **'Save'** button.
